MEDICATION POLICY

Zeeland Public Schools medication policy #5330 states that the Board will require the written prescription from the child's physician accompanied by the written authorization of the parent. This includes prescription and over the counter medication. **NO MEDICATION WILL BE ADMINISTERED WITHOUT THE PROPER FORMS COMPLETED AND SIGNED BY A PHYSICIAN.** Forms are available in the office if you need to pick them up. Management plans must now be on file for allergy, asthma, seizure, and diabetes management.

All medication must be brought to the office by a parent or guardian. Medicine is not allowed on the bus nor is it to be brought in by the student. All medication must be in its original container or prescription bottle with current dates and dosages matching the doctor's prescription.

When Students Have a Change in Transportation

- If you did not send a note, please notify the office before 3:00. We will get a message to the teacher.
- If you are not here at the end of the day and your child does not have a note they will be sent home on the bus.

Z-Pass Bus Tags

Each student is assigned a bus tag that they should carry with them every day, scanning it as they ride a bus to and from home, as well as field trips or athletic events.

ZPass+ is a feature that gives parents notifications of where and when their child gets on or off the school bus. Parents can activate the account either online at www.zpassplus.com and signing up to receive instant messaging to a cell phone or an email account, or by contacting Zonar Systems Customer Service 1-877-843-3847.

Parents will need their child's Zpass card number to activate. A small monthly fee may apply.
