Dressing for the Weather

There might be an unusual situation where a student needs to stay inside, but being outside does not cause illness.

When considering a request to allow a student to stay in for health reasons, please consider whether your child should really be in school or not. It might be better to stay home to avoid spreading the illness to other students.
